### Directive (3/2018)

#### RECOVERY OF PERSONS FROM WATER

Applicable to: All Ship - owners, Ship Operators, Flag State Surveyors, Recognized Organizations, Masters and Officers of Myanmar Flagged Ships.

- 1. The Department of Marine Administration circulates this directive in the exercise of the power of Section 294 (B), paragraph (b) of Myanmar Merchant Shipping Act 1923, as amended.
- 2. This directive applies to Myanmar flagged cargo ships 500 GT and upwards and all passenger ships on international voyages for recovery of persons from the water.
- 3. The Department of Marine Administration set out that the above-mentioned ships shall have ship-specific plans and procedures for recovery of persons from the water in accordance with SOLAS Reg: III/17-1.
- Masters or owners of Myanmar flagged ships shall develop above-mentioned plans in accordance with the guidance set out in the circulars of MSC.1/Circ.1447 Guidelines for the Development of Plans and Procedures for Recovery of Persons from the Water, MSC.1/Circ.1182 Guide to Recovery Techniques and MSC.1/Circ.1185/Rev.1 Guide for Cold Water Survival.
- 5. Such plans and procedures shall be developed as a part of the emergency preparedness plan under "Shipboard Emergency Response Procedures" in the shipboard and shore-based Safety Management System as required by paragraph 8 of part A of the International Safety Management (ISM) code.
