AMENDMENT TO MARINE GUIDANCE (6/2021)



Summary

This Marine Guidance provides amendments to ANNEX (P.21.1) of Marine Guidance (6/2021) concerning the system for maritime education, training, examination, and certification for the Efficient Deck Hand Course, as required by the National Legislation.

1. The Department of Marine Administration (DMA) issued Marine Guidance (6/2021) relating to "Guidance for maritime education & training, examination and certification for seafarers" on 22 October 2021.
2. This Marine Guidance serves to provide the amendments as follow to ANNEX (P.21.1) of Marine Guidance (6/2021) concerning the system of Maritime Education & Training, Examination and Certification for the Efficient Deck Hand Course, as required by the National Legislation for seafarers who is designated to perform the function at the support level:
 - (a) sub-paragraph B of the paragraph 1 is deleted; and
 - (b) the existing sub-paragraph C of the paragraph 1 is renumbered as B.
3. DMA shall administer, supervise and monitor every stage of implementation to ensure compliance with the standards set by this Marine Guidance.
4. This Marine Guidance shall enter into force on the date of issue.
