Statement of Compliance for EU Ship Recycling Regulation

Applicable to:

Shipowners, Managers, Operators, Masters of Myanmar flagged Ships

and Recognized Organizations

Reference

Article 12(6) of the Regulation (EU) 1257/2013

Summary

This guidance provides the instruction for Myanmar flagged ships visiting EU waters to keep Statement of Compliance (SOC) for inventory of hazardous materials on board.

- 1. The EU Ship Recycling Regulation (EU SRR), entered into force on 1st January 2021, Article 12 paragraph 6 of Regulation (EU) 1257/2013 requires EU flagged ships and non-EU flagged ships which are calling to EU ports shall be provided with a Statement of Compliance (SOC) which shall be issued after verification of the Inventory of Hazardous Materials (IHM) by the flag State or a Recognized Organization in accordance with EU SRR.
- 2. In this regard, Myanmar flagged ships are required to carry such SOC when entering a port or waters of a Member State of EU by 1st January 2021.
- 3. Since the legislative requirements for ship recycling are not yet established in Myanmar, the Department of Marine Administration accepts our Recognized Organizations to issue the subject Statement of Compliance (SOC) for compliance with the Regulation (EU) 1257/2013.
